TITLE OF POST: Media Studies Teacher

RESPONSIBLE TO: Head of Faculty - English

PURPOSE OF JOB:

To provide and contribute to the teaching of Media Studies under the direction of the Line Manager, in accordance with the national curriculum and using the appropriate syllabus, materials and schemes of work.

Responsibilities will include:

- To demonstrate sound classroom practice and innovation
- To teach Media Studies across the ability range at Key Stages 3, 4 and 5
- To mark and assess work regularly and to take part in the department's quality assurance procedures
- To monitor student progress and set targets to ensure expected progress is achieved
- To work as part of a team, attend regular meetings and provide a major input into departmental development
- To develop the contribution of Media Studies to the School Improvement Plan
- To work effectively with the English Department
- To participate in the school's weekly enrichment programme
- To take responsibility for a tutor group within the school's vertical tutoring system
- To follow the school's behaviour for learning policy
- To contribute to the wider life of the school
- To participate in the school's programme of continuing professional development
- To work with appropriate providers to ensure successful development of teaching skills for all staff
