Thank you very much for your interest in the post of Head of Physics at The Boswells School. The school is an extremely popular, oversubscribed and very successful 11-18 school situated in the north of Chelmsford, Essex. The school is moving 'towards outstanding' and we are a dynamic, forward thinking organisation who value our staff and the impact they make on our students.

The role that you are applying for is a crucial post in the development of the school and the educational provision we offer our students. Our Science results at GCSE were excellent with 66% of our students achieving a 9-4 grade in Combined Science. In GCSE Triple science Biology, Physics and Chemistry achieved over 98% Grades 9-4. This was above the national averages. Our performance at A Level was also very successful with Physics achieving 57% A\*-B grades and 100% A\*-E grades. This was also matched with outstanding Biology and Chemistry results.
