Job Purpose	To contribute to the smooth running of the School by organising and managing the cleaning team and undertaking effective supervision, caretaking maintenance, Health & Safety and security of the site and related resources.	
Duties	 The duties of the post as outlined will be subject to the appropriate risk assessment, safe systems of work and appropriate equipment being available and the relevant competencies of the post holder. Security and Supervision To organise and manage the work of the cleaning team. Act as keyholder and carrying out security procedures for the buildings and grounds. The routine and nonroutine opening of premises and grounds. Responding to calls outside normal working hours as a result of break-ins etc. and/or the setting off of the burglar alarm(s). Providing access, where possible, to the premises and classrooms in the event of snow or minor flooding or similar emergency situations. Dealing with enquiries from officers and employees of the Local Education Authority, workers and contractors and, where appropriate in liaison with the Headteacher/School Business Manager Attempting to prevent unauthorised access onto the school premises or grounds. (Note: in fulfilling this responsibility all employees are expected to work within established school procedures and the Code of Practice No. 32(S) Managing Violence in Schools).

•	Ensuring that all areas within the confines of the site
	are free from litter and that all drains and gullies are
	free flowing and clean.
•	Making arrangements for the delivery of stores,
	materials and other goods and their conveyance to
	their points of distribution. Dispatching laundry, goods,
	materials etc.
•	Ensuring that adequate supplies of cleaning materials
	and other supplies are available.
•	Ensuring that all caretaking equipment is in a safe and
	working condition and arranging for their repair as
	appropriate.
•	Preparing the school premises and site for out of
	school activities and clearing up after these activities.
	Supporting the School PTA by attending events and

	helping clearing up afterwards.
	 Other duties Testing portable electrical equipment if trained and accredited to do so. Assisting in the recruitment and selection of cleaning staff and the allocation of duties and hours of work. Planning own work and that of cleaning staff. Issues relating to supervision/ management of staff. Provide/arrange the appropriate induction and training of cleaning staff. Completing claims for caretaking fees for lettings and making out forms for the requisition of stores and repairs. Maintenance of Inventory of/in respect of all school equipment. Carrying out an annual check of equipment against the Inventory.
	 <u>Health & Safety</u> To act as Health and Safety Co-ordinator, after appropriate training, to support the Headteacher and School Business Manager in ensuring the school is compliant with all its Health and Safety responsibilities and duties Ensuring the implementation and compliance with appropriate Codes of Practice throughout the School (in relation to premises and caretaking/cleaning issues) in liaison with the Health and Safety Officer for the School. Organising Fire Drills and acting as Fire Marshall during these drills in negotiation with the Health & Safety Officer. Maintain fire extinguishers and liaise with local companies for their regular service contract.
	Monitoring the appropriate Health and Safety procedures in use in the School and reporting any issues to the Health and Safety Officer for the School. <u>General</u> Such other duties relating to the use of the premises and site as may be necessary from time to time in accordance with established local practice or with the reasonable requirements of the School and Governing Body. The duties may be varied by the Headteacher and/or Governing Body to meet changed circumstances in a manner compatible with the post held.
