JOB DESCRIPTION

TEACHER OF THE DEAF

Responsible to:

DUTIES:

The Conditions of Employment for School Teachers specify the general professional duties of all teachers. In addition, certain particular duties are reasonably required to be exercised and completed in a satisfactory manner.

PARTICULAR DUTIES:

- To be responsible, as appropriate, for the leadership, management and organisation of the Resource Base
- To be responsible for a group of Hearing Impaired pupils, working in mainstream and within the Resource Base

MAIN ACTIVITIES ATTRIBUTABLE TO DUTIES:

- 1. To display good teaching practice in line with the aims and objectives of the School Policy.
- 2. To share responsibility with colleagues for promoting and safeguarding the welfare of pupils at the school
- 3. To carry out statutory assessment requirements in line with Government Policy and work closely with the Special Needs Support Service, the Educational Psychology Service and School Staff.
- 4. To contribute to reviews and reassessments and provide information to parents.
- 5. To liaise with relevant teaching staff so that progress is carefully monitored.
- To work closely with colleagues in the planning and preparation of work, assessment and record-keeping of individual education programmes to enhance children's progress and their access to the National Curriculum.
- 7. To assist with providing INSET within the school.

COORDINATION:

- Ensuring consistent agreed policy throughout the school.
- Ensuring that targets in the School Development Plan related to the area are achieved.

MONITORING AND REVIEW:

- Monitoring and reviewing policy, practise and provision
- Involving all staff in the review and development of policy
- Monitoring and evaluating children's progress and achievements in the Resource Base.

THE RESPONSIBILITY MUST:

- Impact on educational progress beyond the teacher's assigned pupils
- Involve leading, developing and enhancing the teaching practice of others
- Involve accountability for leading, managing and developing the Resource Base.
