## About Danbury Park Community Primary School

Opened in 1974 Danbury Park School is set in an enviable position on the edge of the 80 acre Danbury Country Park, providing it with a wonderful backdrop of rolling parkland and much interesting flora and fauna. Our pupils are well-motivated, very well behaved and talented children from very supportive homes. There is a real sense of school and home working together, which is picked up very clearly by the children.

The school has gained a fine reputation in the past years for academic, sporting and musical excellence. It enters many competitions and festivals which add much to school life.

### Organisation

Currently the school is over-subscribed. There are 257 children on roll organised in nine classes; some single aged; some mixed aged. As well as the nine class teachers we have a SEND leader and Pastoral Manager and dedicated PPA teachers specialising in Music, French and PE. Each class has a Learning Support Assistant five mornings per week with the two youngest classes having full-time LSA support.

#### Curriculum

We teach through a themed approach so that learning is linked and relevant to the children. Extensive mutual support is provided amongst the staff both teaching and non-teaching. The school is determined that the curriculum should be kept as broad as possible and consequently great emphasis is placed upon PE, science and the arts. Additionally, we offer instrumental tuition.

The school has a fully equipped ICT suite that offers 15 networked machines in addition to trolleys of laptops and tablets which are used in the classes. We also have interactive screens in each classroom.

Danbury Park has strong links with the local secondary school and primary schools, sharing expertise and arranging joint activities sharing teaching and learning projects to enhance our curriculum, as well as coming together for continuing professional development. We link with Great Baddow High Sports College as part of the sports network.

### **Extra-Curricular Activities**

Danbury Park School has a wide variety of extracurricular clubs and activities for its pupils. Clubs offered include tag rugby, football, netball, multi-skills and art.

#### Standards

Danbury Park has high academic expectations and standards.

Behaviour throughout the school is exemplary with the children motivated and eager to learn.

The school is immensely proud of its two consecutive Ofsted grading of o*utstanding* overall, the latest being in November 2013.
