THE FACULTY

The Maths department at Moulsham High School is fully committed to raising standards and as such is highly regarded by parents and students alike. G.C.S.E. results are consistently above national averages and the team is strong, conscientious and supportive.

The department has eight classrooms, all of which are located adjacent to each other in the quadrangle of the Old School building. It has access to a bookable suite of 30 computers. Staff also have the use of a small staffroom which is located nearby. Each classroom has an interactive whiteboard and is wireless networked. Every member of staff is provided with his/her own laptop.

The successful candidate will be part of a large team of eleven specialists, four of whom are part time.

The work of the department is also supported by a maths 1:1 intervention tutor.

The department often welcomes student teachers from the local SCITT schemes.

Students follow the Edexcel GCSE Mathematics. Approximately 30 students in Year 11 also take G.C.S.E. Statistics each year.

Years 12/13 The Edexcel maths and further maths syllabuses are followed.
