- Lead the class team to ensure effective team working for the benefit of the pupils
- Work in effective partnership with parents/carers, educational psychologists, therapists, social services and other outside agencies who may be involved with pupils for whom you have a responsibility
- Work collaboratively with colleagues to ensure the aims of the school are achieved
- Have a thorough awareness of and regard for the confidential nature of many aspects of school information relating to individual pupils
- Promote positive pupil behaviour in line with school policies
- Take part as required in meetings in relation to the curriculum and organisation of the school
- Participate in professional development as outlined in the school development plan or identified through the appraisal process and take responsibility for own development
- Ensure the activities in which pupils are engaged are conducted safely and in line with school policy
- Undertake full safeguarding checks and training and report safeguarding concerns in line with school procedure.
