Job Purpose	To work as part of a team in the school's catering facilities ensuring the equipment, kitchen, dining hall and surrounding areas are cleaned and maintained to meet hygiene and health and safety standards at all times.
Duties	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To undertake all aspects of cleaning equipment (light and heavy), walls (up to 6ft.) floors, fixtures and fittings, cooking utensils, cutlery, glassware etc. as directed. • During service times, to ensure that tables and counters are as clean as reasonably practicable and adequately stocked. • Receive and check catering deliveries against invoice and store in the appropriate area. • Monitor and record temperatures of catering deliveries as required • To keep the storeroom clean and tidy at all times. • To clean staff toilet, changing room and staff room at the end of each day. • To hose out and clean all bins at the end of each week or as directed. • To lift and move heavy equipment as directed • Assist in the preparation of equipment as directed. • To maintain a high standard of personal and general cleanliness and hygiene to comply with statutory and school regulations. • To attend training activities and/or meetings as required. • Report immediately any accidents, fire, theft, loss, damage, unfit food or other irregularities and take such action as may be appropriate or possible. • The duties above are neither exclusive nor exhaustive and the post holder may be required by the Headteacher to carry out appropriate duties within the context of the job, skills and grade.
