Job Purpose	To supervise the cleaners
Duties	Involvement in interviewing cleaning staff
General	 Ensure all toilets are clean, clear of litter, graffiti and report any damage to Caretakers. Carry out same after lunch break Pick up any rooms/areas not cleaned the previous evening/morning Spot clean graffiti in corridors Ensure corridors are clear of litter Order stock Organise work schedules for cleaners Maintenance of equipment Clean Windows/showcases Clean any classrooms that may have free periods, before the end of the school day Greet cleaners, allocate work areas and distribute keys accordingly Support cleaners in their needs and requirements Carry out audit of standards Regular training for cleaners Concentrate on working with a cleaner once a month to enable any problems to be addressed Address any issues raised by teaching/administration staff in the Daily Record Book Carry out disciplinary procedures for cleaning staff Ensure areas are covered if short staffed and cover when necessary Report to Premises Manager at weekly meeting Responsible for Health and Safety of Cleaners Assist Caretakers as required
