Dear Colleague,

Thank you very much for your interest in the post of Teacher of English at The Boswells School. We are an extremely popular, oversubscribed and very successful 11-18 school who values our staff and the impact they make on our students.

In 2019, at GCSE 83% of students achieved a good pass in English. This measure is significantly above the national average, as was the percentage of students achieving a strong pass (Grade 5+). The school's overall Progress 8 figure was 0.27. At A Level, 55% of all grades awarded were A*-B grades and 88% A*-C grades. All these measures of attainment are significantly above local and national averages and mean we are one of the highest performing non selective state schools in Essex for A Levels.
