Assess, monitor, record and report on the learning needs, progress and achievements of assigned pupils, making accurate and productive use of assessment. Adapt teaching to respond to the strengths and needs of pupils. Set high expectations for learning and behaviour which inspire, motivate and challenge pupils to achieve their best. Demonstrate good subject and curriculum knowledge.
