THE FACULTY

This highly motivated and hard-working department has six members of staff, led by the Head of Faculty.

The successful applicant would be joining a committed and supportive team which thrives on academic success. The department is represented at Bridge Academy Trust and whole-school meetings and each staff member is encouraged to take an active part in departmental, Trust, whole-school, county and national INSET initiatives.

The department is also committed to teacher training in MFL. It has been an active member of the Mid-Essex School-Centred Initial Teacher Training scheme for many years and all members have the opportunity to play a role in the training of future language teachers.

Uptake for languages at the school is strong with around 60% of each cohort in Years 10 and 11 taking a language at GCSE. Our A level groups are growing in number and thriving.

CURRICULUM

Spanish and French are taught throughout the school up to A level. Students in Year 7 are allocated six hours a fortnight of either language, which they continue with throughout Years 8 and 9. The most able group in Year 7, 8 and 9 (1A) are the only group to study both languages, (three hours per language per fortnight).

At Key Stage 4 each language option has six lessons of teaching a fortnight and the Examination Board specification followed is AQA. More able students are required to take the E-Bacc combination of subjects and, therefore, all take a language.

RESOURCES

The department is incredibly well resourced and has a full subscription to Kerboodle for all Key Stages, using Allez for French and Claro for Spanish at KS3. Homework is currently set on Satchel One. Teaching is supplemented by numerous other support materials in the department, both paper based and interactive resources. We currently have subscriptions to Linguascope, Teachit, Twinkl, Frenteacher.net, Exampro and Sentence Builders. Staff actively share resources and an area on the school network is used for this purpose.

The department has **six** classrooms situated together in the attractive setting of the Old School. Each classroom is equipped with a whiteboard with overhead projector. All members of staff have a laptop computer, so that they can make full use of the technology available to support their teaching. Audio files can be played from the laptops through speakers attached to the white board, providing greater clarity of sound.

The MFL department also has access to a bookable ICT room which is shared with other departments.

ENRICHMENT

The faculty offers a wide range of extra- curricular activities, including trips to the BFI for post-16 students and visits to Paris, Madrid and Valencia.

THE POST

The person appointed to this post will be expected to teach Spanish and French at Key Stage 3, and have an ability to teach either or both at G.C.S.E. level. A level teaching could be available for a suitable candidate. The post is suitable for either an ECT or a more experienced teacher. ECTs teach a reduced timetable of 40/50 periods a fortnight. In addition to having a mentor within their department, they also take part in an ECT Induction Programme which is led by an Assistant Headteacher and validated by the Saffron Teaching Alliance.
