May also be required to work at different sites within the Bridge Academy Trust on different projects.

- **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

**Key areas**

- To provide 1st, 2nd and 3rd line support to all users at Ramsey Academy & Richard de Clare Community Academy
- To help develop the School's IT systems.
- To ensure that the integrity of the ICT infrastructure is maintained.
- To support the delivery of ICT across the curriculum.
- To advise staff on emerging technologies as appropriate.
- To contribute to the vision of the ICT development.
- Line management and development of the school's IT apprentice

- **Key responsibilities**

- Maintaining IT systems to a high standard
- Installation of all new IT hardware
- To install and maintain in good working order, on a day-to-day basis, the ICT network systems, hardware and software within the School
- To help regularly test the IT disaster recovery plan
- To document accurately and comprehensively all ICT systems.
- To undertake effective fault diagnosis of all of the School's network and computer systems and assign solutions.
- To maintain a fully comprehensive and up-to-date asset register of all ICT hardware within the School.
- Support Provide both telephone and desktop support to students, teaching and admin staff across Ramsey Academy / Richard de Clare Community Academy
- To communicate effectively with all staff and pupils.
- To assist in the maintenance of server software
- To install software and prepare system images for deployment.
- To manage the anti-virus software on the network
- To have a good working knowledge of relevant current legislation and good practice and ensure compliance.
- Maintain the core services of the school's Management Information System (MIS)

- To liaise and work with teachers and support staff at Ramsey Academy / Richard de Clare Community Academy to ensure effective support for ICT users and systems.
- To manage the School's Internet filtering software.
- To take responsibility for planned projects under the guidance of the IT Director

- **Service and image**

- To develop and project a positive "can do" departmental image, by devising and introducing methods of promoting an effective and proactive ICT service. This to include periodically briefing teaching and support staff on the network and related matters.
- To undertake any other duties reasonably expected of a Network Manager, as agreed with the IT Director.

- **ACCOUNTABILITY:**

- The Network Manager reports directly to the IT Director and liaises closely with the Head Teacher, teaching and support staff.
- The position will be subject to periodic review by a specialist in the same field, as part of a system of appraisal and personal development.
