ABOUT BURNHAM-ON-CROUCH & THE DENGIE

Burnham-on-Crouch is a historic town situated on the banks of the River Crouch in the East Coast of England.

Best known as a yachting centre hosting the internationally famous 'Burnham Week' it also boasts many other attractions as diverse as fossil laden cliffs to a working steam railway museum.

Burnham-on-Crouch is the Capital of the picturesque Dengie 100 much of which is unchanged since its listing in the Domesday Book.

Dengie 100 is a peninsula of land to the east of Chelmsford, Essex bounded by the North Sea to the east, the River Crouch to the south and the River Blackwater to the north.

There are excellent transport links, including a regular bus service to Maldon and Chelmsford, and a direct train line within 5 minutes' walk of the academy, which takes you to London Liverpool Street in under an hour and to Southend Airport in approximately 40 minutes.
