Thank you for showing an interest in the above mentioned post at our school. Roseacres is a happy, friendly school where we aim to be the best we can be. We pride ourselves in the family orientated environment that we have created in partnership with our parents, who are very supportive of our school, rated 'GOOD' in our very first Ofsted Inspection (July 18).

Roseacres only opened in September 2015 with 33 pupils on roll! Now with over 190 pupils and eight classes, it caters for pupils in Years R to Y6. It is on the former site of Takeley Primary that relocated to a brand new school on Priors Green development in Little Canfield. Takeley village has and still is undergoing significant change due to continued local expansion resulting in a high demand for primary school places. Consequently, in September '18 a 'bulge' Reception cohort was admitted and a further building project was undertaken that academic year to provide two additional classrooms, creating a dedicated stand-alone Early Years Unit. September 19 intake is back to our usual number of 30 children.

Roseacres Primary is one of three schools in the multi- academy trust 'The Learning Partnership Trust' (TLPT), Hatfield Heath being the lead school and then Takeley Primary. The Trust's vision is to serve our local communities and children by providing an outstanding education, with an absolute commitment to the highest standards of education, based on a can-do culture of continuous improvement and innovation. As an employee of the Trust, there is the potential for wider professional development opportunities for training and personal development, as we aim to work collaboratively across the schools to share and develop best practice in all staff roles.
