Construction is offered for students in Years 10 and 11 to select as one of their option choices. Once successful they will achieve the BTEC Tech Award Level 2 in Construction & the Built Environment, and you will be a valuable support in this journey. Experience would be preferred but is not essential.

Duties

- Take an active role in the preparation and maintenance of differentiated materials and resources in the learning areas supported
- Offer practical support to students during lesson time, as required by the teacher

- Clean tools, cement mixer and the classroom after the lessons
